Dear Mr. Intermill:

Based upon the issues with the proposed categorized rates discussed with the federal auditor, Fleet Services is withdrawing their request for implementing the categorized rate structure. Fleet Services is requesting approval to continue charging customers in FY15 the approved FY14 business plan rates. In anticipation of approval of the categorized rate structure, the depreciation of vehicles was changed on July 1, 2014 to reflect the actual projected retention life of the vehicle instead of the 40 month straight line method identified in the FY14 business plan. The change in depreciation will not impact the rate charged to customers but will better align the expenses to the life of the vehicle and the revenue collection already spread over the life of the lease.

The continuation of the FY14 rates will allow Fleet Services to begin working on their FY16 business plan rates taking into consider new strategies and opportunities to avoid the collection of excess retained earnings such as changing the mileage component in the individualized rate structure.

To reduce the excess retained earnings collected in FY14 and offset lower fuel costs, Fleet Services is proposing a \$1M "Per Mile" rebate on the December invoices which are issued in January, 2015. This rebate of approximately \$.05 per mile will be distributed based on the actual miles driven in FY14. The attached worksheet identifies the amount that will be rebated to each customer leasing a Fleet Services vehicle with a fuel component. In addition, Fleet Services will review projected retained earnings in April and work with FMR and MMB to determine if another rebate is necessary.

This chart does not include the 50 cent per gallon credit for the use of E85 fuel. This credit is an increase of 25 cents from FY2013.

Fuel charged to agencies for agency owned vehicles is charged at cost on a reimbursement basis.

In some cases, lease rates are developed that do not include all of the components documented on page.39. Rates for MNSCU and political subdivisions do not include fuel. Rates for political subdivisions do not include insurance. If state customers wish to contribute the vehicle expense portion of the rate, rates are developed that do not include vehicle expense or related interest expense.

Costs for items removed from vehicles may be charged to the customer based on replacement cost or anticipated loss from sale. The cost of mechanical repair work due to misuse, abuse, neglect of equipment, or smoking in the vehicle is the responsibility of the customer. Fleet Services may charge the customer for mechanical repair resulting from misuse, abuse, or neglect of equipment or the additional cost for smoke removal.

Customers are charged an early termination fee of \$500. Vehicles turned in with physical damaged may be repaired with the customer being responsible for up to the \$500 insurance deductible.
